COURSE OVERVIEW

Seventh Grade Social Studies continues with World Area Studies with a focus on SW Asia, Africa, and SE Asia. Topics include geography, culture (including world religions), environmental issues, history (20th and 21st century), economics (how countries answer the three basic questions) and government (types of governments found in various areas).

OBJECTIVE
